The Natural Resources Technician position is an entry level trainee position into a natural resources management career path. The NRT-E is responsible for performing day to day tasks and projects related to natural resource management practices within the operations of the Klawock Indigenous Stewards Forest Partnership (KISFP) project area.

The basic function of this position will be to assist the Klawock Indigenous Stewards Forest Partnership with natural resource data collection and project implementation. You will be expected to work cooperatively with private landowners, and local, state, and federal agency staff in the course of collecting and analyzing natural resource data; lead the implementation of natural resource related measuring and monitoring activities for water quality and groundwater, including field work, data entry, and analysis; develop and maintain resource inventories and evaluations, as needed for projects; assist with public outreach efforts on conservation and natural resource issues, as required; and other duties as assigned by your assigned supervisor. The individual will be expected to navigate to off-site locations, work in remote and rugged locations under a variety of weather conditions, traverse difficult upland and instream terrain, and carry field equipment necessary to complete required job tasks
